1. Introduction

Runspire Nottingham is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all its members. This Code of Conduct outlines the principles and expectations for behaviour within our club. By participating in any club activities, members agree to adhere to this Code of Conduct.

2. Respect and Inclusivity

- a) Respect: Treat all members, volunteers, and officials with respect and dignity, regardless of their background, age, gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, or ability.

- c) Medical Conditions: Inform club officials of any medical conditions or injuries that may affect your participation. Respect the decisions of individuals regarding their own health and safety.

4. Sportsmanship

- a) Fair Play: Always display good sportsmanship. Respect the rules and regulations of races and events, as well as the efforts of fellow participants.
- b) Support: Encourage and support fellow members, regardless of their skill level or pace. Celebrate individual achievements and milestones within the club.
- c) Conflict Resolution: Address conflicts or disputes in a constructive and respectful manner. Seek assistance from club officials if needed to resolve any issues peacefully.

- b) Social Media: Exercise discretion and professionalism when posting on social media platforms. Avoid sharing content that may reflect negatively on the club or its members.
- c) Uniform: Wear club attire or insignia proudly during club activities and events, where appropriate.

- Adherence to Policies: Familiarise yourself with and adhere to all club policies, including this Code of Conduct, as well as any rules or guidelines set forth by relevant governing bodies.
